#### **Light Rail Planning for Tennessee**

Another noteworthy event of interest to our membership:

The Tennessee Department of Transportation will conduct a public involvement meeting in Memphis on Tuesday, November 12, 2002, to present topics related to the Tennessee Rail System Plan. The meeting will be held in Meeting Room C of the Memphis/Shelby County Library located on 3030 Poplar Ave. Meeting time will from 6pm to 8:30pm.

The Department is developing a comprehensive rail plan to provide policy, procedural, and system management guidance defining a new role for the department in rail system projects.

Some of the topics that will be presented by TDOT's consultant team include an improved Bristol-Knoxville-Nashville-Memphis rail connection in Tennessee, a proposed Memphis rail bypass, potential rail system

improvements in Tennessee, and the potential for intercity passenger rail service for Tennessee.
