We just received word that our previously announced speaker has been called away to China for the next 2-weeks so we have had a speaker/program change for our meeting next Tuesday. We now will have:

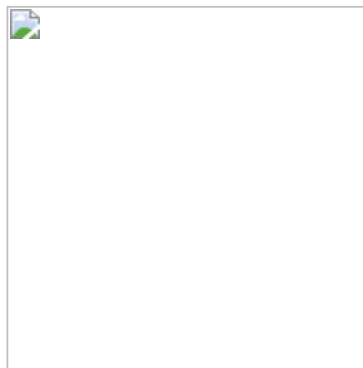
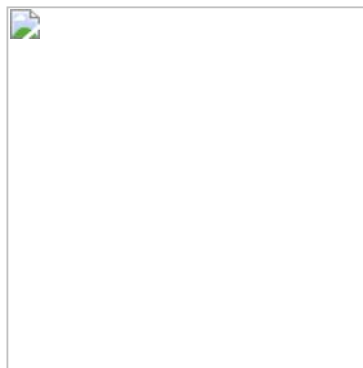
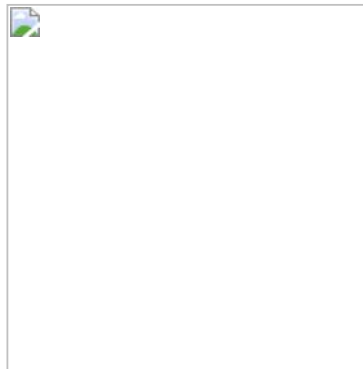
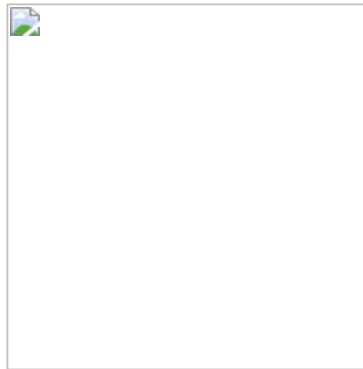
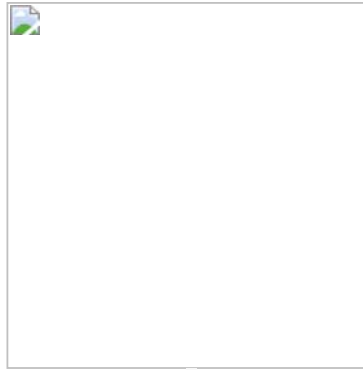
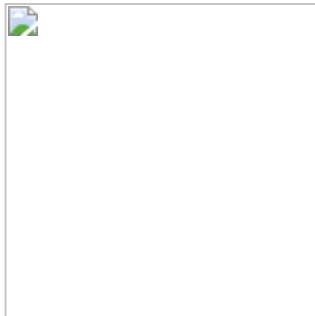

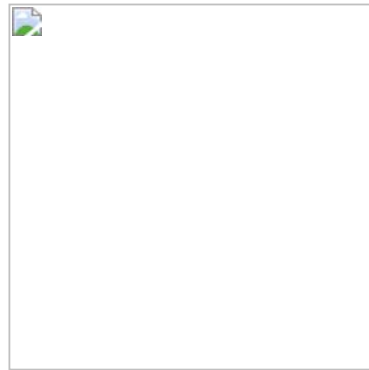
November 11th

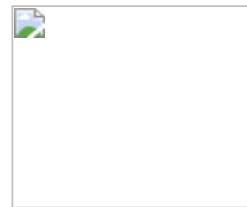
