We are very please to present Dr. Stephanie Ivey as our November speaker.

Dr. Stephanie Ivey is an Associate Professor with the Department of Civil Engineering and director of the Intermodal Freight Transportation Institute and the Southeast Transportation Workforce Center at the University of Memphis. Her research includes focus on journey to school in urban areas, transportation planning, livability assessment in freight-centric communities, and strategies to engage citizens in the transportation planning process. She also has a strong record of focused workforce research and outreach related to increasing representation of women in STEM and particularly in transportation.

Ivey directs the West Tennessee STEM Hub, and has served as PI/co-PI on over \$3 M in funded projects for STEM education research. She is a member of the STEM Leadership Council for Tennessee.

She serves as faculty advisor for the University of Memphis student chapters of the Institute of Transportation Engineers and WTS, Volunteer Coordinator for the ITE Transportation Education Council, and is a member of the TRB Standing committee on Maintenance and Operations Personnel and the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis Transportation Industry Council.
